Documents		Passport(You must assure that the validity of the passport has over six months left) 2 Passport Photos, 1 Original Copy of Resident Registration in English)
Electronics		Alarm Clock, Wristwatch, Digital Camera(not required) Electric Mosquito Repellents, Electric Dictionary(Dictionaries in cellphones are not allowed) * Please do not bring expensive items such as any gaming consoles, cell phone and etc containing a game function. In case of carrying those items, we will confiscate them after your arrival and return them when the camp finishes.

POLICIES

- When registering, the deposit is \$500 and it will not be refunded in case that the student cancel his/her enrollment after the registration is finalized.
- The balance exclusive of the deposit must be paid in full 4 weeks before the start of the camp.
- All charges for the camp are not allowed to be carried over or transferred to.
- If a student cancels his/her enrollment with less than a 2-weeks from the scheduled start date, 50% of all charges except for the \$500 registration fee will be refunded. (In case of any cancellation after that time, none of charges will be refunded)
- After the start of the camp if a student unilaterally cancels his/her enrollment without any valid reason, none of charges will be refunded and all costs caused by this will be paid by his/her guardian's expense.
- During the period of the camp, if a student returns home to enter a hospital due to his/her health problems, 50% of remaining charges except airfare according to the remaining period will be refunded. However, none of charges will be refunded if it is caused by his/her homesickness or maladjustment.
- During the period of the camp, if a student enters a hospital for a treatment, one of the managers in the camp will take care of procedures for hospitalization. Hospital bills caused by this are paid in advance by his/her guardian, and the insurance company compensates them according to its insurance policy.
- In case of any unexpected incidents during the period of the camp, they are covered by the insurance policy that the organizer of the camp insured.
- ▶ In case it is impossible to do a class during the period of the camp because of any strike from a teacher, resignation, lack of values of a student (habitual absences, poor attitude, etc.) and so on, CIEC will provide a substitute teacher.
- CEBU IVY EDU CENTER is not responsible for any damage caused by the reasons which cannot be controlled such as natural and unexpected disasters, war, aircraft hijacking, aircraft accident, riot, disease, etc.
- If a student does not put his/her money and valuables under the care of the managers, CEBU IVY EDU CENTER is not responsible for any loss caused by his/her fault and he/she will accept full responsibility for such loss.
 In case of any unpredictable and uncontrollable accidents such as fights among students, injury by slipping and falling, possible safety accident and others CEBU IVY CENTER will determine the best course of action, informing his/her guardian the situation of what happened promptly. However, the student and his/her guardian cannot hold CEBU IVY CENTER responsible for it. Medical expenses and post treatments caused by them are covered by the insurance policy the organizer of the camp insured before the start of the camp and excess costs above the coverage are paid by the student or his/her guardian.
